my queer friends

they don't get it because


normality is comfortable

so i just left, not

knowing what i was

doing, not knowing

where to go. only now

↳ all
it makes sense.

i came out to them
just a few days ago, as
bi and trans.

u was

expecting the worst: them not
accepting it, not supporting
me.

when i received their
answers, i was so surprised

to see that they

actually seemed to want

to learn and listen...

but coming out is

not the most difficult part

of this. i expected the doubts

the intrusive questions, the
lack of actual support (i can't
pay for hormones on my own...)
and now that i came back
to live with them, i know
the meaning of straight cis
acceptance: it's actually cis
hypocrisy: the desire for

me to be

impossible, not too queer.

i can be with girls but i

can't transition. or i can

transition but only if i

pass. not too queer, because

they are scared that i don't

fit into this society. but i

already don't fit in cis straight

society: i never was able to.

Now i am stuck in a
weird entre-deux of
neither being supported nor
rejected. Leaving and
coming-out didn't feel like a
choice at all, it felt
like the thing i had to do
in order to survive some
goes for my desire to take

T: it's more of a survival

-strategy than a ~~the~~ fucking
"choice". But what about all

the trans people who ~~are~~

don't have the social
resources to transition,

come-out or leave a
toxic family? When I see

all the trans ppl asking

financial help on social

networks, I always feel deeply

uncomfortable, because what

12 about those who are

deprived from this social
capital? We urgently need
allies to support us
financially but we
also urgently need
collective solutions that
don't exclude the trans
people who don't have
these social resources.


? MISANDRY?
